Please give us a brief report for this trauma fellowship program:

I arrived at Hong Kong in 14th Sep. And the day I came to OLC and met Margaret. She introduced me to Dr. Tang and he guided me in PWH. My training was started from 17th Sep.

Every day we had a ward round, and we had a Grand round with Prof. Leung on Tuesday & Thursday. During a round, doctors saw and talked with patients and discussed the cases over films or data. I learned how to select the operation (urgency, implant, adaptation of operation, ...)

On Wednesday we had a Wednesday meeting. I could participate in it only a few times. Last 2 Wednesdays we had a HKOA rehearsal.

I could see many presentations. They were filled with special and new knowledges. After presentation audience discussed about contents of it and give advices. I learned the way of presentation there, too.

On Friday morning we had a X-ray meeting. It was very difficult and I couldn't understand well. But I thought it good to have a chance taking lectures from specialists.

We had a clinic on Tuesday and Friday. I couldn't understand the talk between Dr. Tang and patients. But Dr. Tang told me the outline.

Some patients had a unbelievable recovery and I was surprised at it. At the same time I realized the importance of our job.

We had operations on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. Those were my favorite times. I could experience many operations (gamma nail, IM nail, DHS, locking plate, below knee amputation, pelvic fracture, ...)

There had been no operation using navigation, but my last operation day, I could participate in the operation. It was very happy.

The operation was ~~was~~ very exciting and interesting for me!! Some day I want to operate like it by myself.

I experienced ~~some~~ "evening call", too. It was very hard (we had 4 operations and it ~~started~~ finished at 4 AM). But it was interesting.

On 22nd Sep, I attended to international symposium at CUHK.

It was organized by CUHK, department of O & T. Its theme ^{was} "Comprehensive Care of Fragility Fractures". I heard a presentation by Dr., ~~was~~ nurse, rehabilitation staff, therapist, psychologist and so on. It was useful to think about fractures in the elderly from many points of view.
